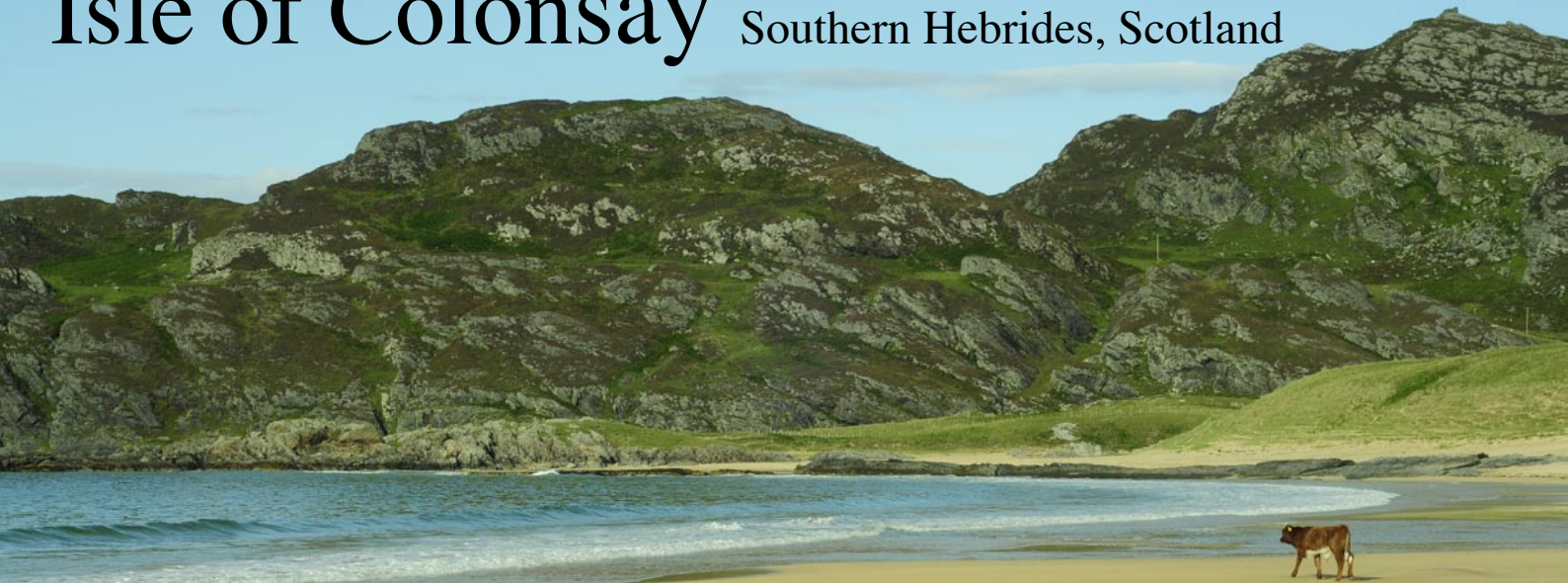


# Alister Annie's Cottage

## Isle of Colonsay Southern Hebrides, Scotland



Colonsay is a beautiful and remote Scottish island. With a population of just 100, it sits on the edge of the Atlantic, two and a half hours out from Oban by regular ferry.

A lovely place for a week or two of real escape, the island has miles of untouched coastline and hills to walk. The well known Kiloran bay is a lovely sandy beach, wonderful for kids and swimming. There is a small and excellent hotel restaurant and pub, a good shop, a tiny but wonderful bookshop, a micro brewery, a charming links golf course and an airstrip with occasional flights to the mainland.

Our lovely stone crofters cottage, on its own little site within the Upper Kilchattan hamlet, sleeps 4/5. It is arranged on 2 levels: on the ground floor there is a sitting room with a coal fire, a kitchen/dining room, as well as the bathroom. There is a washing machine and a hanging clothes dryer. Upstairs there are 2 bedrooms: one double (with an extra bed for a child) and one twin, these are accessed by steep ladder style staircases.

A private track leads to our enclosed garden that keeps the sheep out from the surrounding crofting land. The cottage has long views to the sea and to a nearby inland fishing loch. Dogs welcome.
